

SOME FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

What does it cost?

The program is offered at no cost to the participants.

Is it only for men and women that have been in trouble or coming from jail?

No. The program is open to anyone who thinks they can benefit from it.

What is the age limit?

18+

Do I need a high school diploma or GED?

No.

Do you have night classes?

We do not currently offer night classes.

Do you provide bus tokens/bus pass?

All participants are provided a stipend to cover transportation and food cost while providing volunteer services.

What kinds of volunteer services do you provide?

We successfully and efficiently provide manpower at the Astros baseball games and the Texans football games by running their concession stands and or maintaining an accurate count of inventory. We are a work readiness program not an employment agency.

What if I get a job?

In the event you get a job, go to work... that's our goal for people – that they become self-sufficient.

What kind of training do you offer?

We do "soft skill training" which means that we do not do anything technical. We work on interviewing techniques and behavior modification. We teach cashiers

What is the program about?

The program is designed to assist individuals with changing their old behaviors and attitudes. It's about changing old negative behaviors and empowering individuals with the tools necessary to not only get a "job" but how to develop a career.
